EHCA is a private, nonprofit agency headquartered in Erie, Pennsylvania, providing services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Erie, Crawford, and Venango counties. EHCA programs are licensed annually by the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services. Admissions, the provision of services, and referrals of persons for services shall be made without regard to race, color, gender, age, national origin, religious affiliation, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, or limited English proficiency.

MOVE (Making Opportunities for Volunteerism and Exploration) is a dually-licensed adult and older adult (60+) day program that emphasizes community exploration, including recreation and volunteerism. MOVE fosters independence and inclusion by focusing on everyone's unique abilities and personal interests.

MOVE provides a creative environment for individuals to express themselves through the visual and performing arts. Art engages the senses and builds confidence. MOVE brings together art and dance partners to enrich the lives of the people we serve. It empowers individuals through socialization, creative expression (with an emphasis on the arts), independent living skills, and more.

MOVE's Direct Support Professionals are trained to serve individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and those with complex medical needs. MOVE is located in a fully accessible building with nursing services, medication administration, and therapeutic services.



MOVE encourages everyone to explore, create, engage, and aspire.

- Opportunities to explore and develop personal interests and goals

All participation can be completed independently or with the assistance of communication devices, adaptive equipment, and/or MOVE staff.
