MOVE enhances people's independence and community inclusion by focusing on each person's abilities and interests. Through unique partnerships with many local organizations, participants contribute meaningful, productive work as volunteers. They also participate in social organizations and recreational activities. This participation can be accomplished independently or with the assistance of communication devices, adaptive equipment, and/or physical assistance from MOVE staff.

MOVE also provides a creative environment for individuals to express themselves through the visual and performing arts. Art engages the senses and builds confidence through beauty, accomplishment, appreciation, and applause. Opportunities include Partners in Art, Partners in Dance, craft projects, and selling creations at art exhibits and craft shows

EHCA's MOVE program offers area residents and their families an additional choice for daytime services. The facility is fully accessible and offers state-of-the-art technology. Nursing, medication administration, and therapeutic services are available as needed. Each person will be fully engaged in his/her choice of interests and actively integrated in the community.
